

Viewing your exam result online

If you have taken one of our exams we want to make sure you receive your result as quickly as possible. By registering for our [Results Online](#) website you will be able to view your results as soon as they become available. You'll also receive an email letting you know that your results have been released.

You can register for the site at any point from when you receive your **Confirmation of Entry** from your exam centre; you do not need to wait until after the exam. You will need the **ID number** and **Secret number** shown on your Confirmation of Entry in order to register. If you haven't received these details, please [contact your exam centre](#) for assistance.

Results for paper-based exams are generally released around four to six weeks after the date of the exam. Results for computer-based tests are released around two weeks after the exam.

How to register

Before using the service, you will need to register and create a password. Please see the guide below for details on how to do this (click on the image for a larger version).
